TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

- This tournament is open for all men over the age of 16.
- The attached entry form must be completed in full and sent with the payment by 15 September 2011.
- Submitting an application does not guarantee a place in the tournament. Places will be secured upon clearance of payment.
- The first 40 registered teams will be placed into 8 groups and round robin league matches will be played in each group.
- Teams in each group will be decided by draws in front of Blackburn with Darwen counsellors (everyone is welcome)
- Competitors must report to the Referee on arrival and must not leave the hall without the referee's permission until eliminated from all events if they still have any games left.
- Any competitor/ team not ready to play when called will be liable to be scratched.
- Matches will be started as per schedule and players are requested to report to the court on time.
- Warming up times in the court will be restricted to 5 minutes before a scheduled game.
- The BWF ruling of three sets to 21 points will operate and feather shuttlecocks will be used.

- No food or beverages will be allowed inside the courts. Refreshments will be provided in a separate area within the venue.
- The Tournament Technical Committee will have the final decision in any dispute or any unusual unexpected circumstances/ situation not previously mentioned or which may arise during game or tournament.
- We will operate a zero tolerance policy, Any team/ players failing to adhere to the rules or causing disruption to the smooth functioning of the tournament, will be politely asked to leave.
- The awards will be presented after the final game on 16/10/2011

How to get to Audley Sports Centre

From M65: Take junction 5 and head towards Blackburn, onto A677.

Go past the Royal Blackburn hospital on your right.

Take right onto Bennington Street, and then at the traffic lights, keep to your right.

Head towards Audley Range, and at the first mini-roundabout, take the first exit, onto Chester Street.

After about 500 yards, Audley Sports Centre is on your right.
